- a) the shuttle bus service
- b) the public means of transportation
- c) your own car

a) Shuttle Bus Service

Shuttle Bus Stop: Syntagma Square

The shuttle bus will be leaving daily from Syntagma Square just outside the Central Post Office (ELTA Syntagmatos). To view the exact point of departure please click here (map in pdf).

- Please note that there might be slight changes in the time of departure from Anavyssos and the time of arrival at the conference venue.
- Please make sure that you arrive at the shuttle bus stop in Syntagma Square at least 5 minutes before departure time.
- The shuttle bus service is free of charge.

B) Using Public Means of Transportation

KTEL Bus Service

You can either use the Athens-Anavyssos bus service or the Athens-Sounio bus service (both depart from Aigyptou Square, just opposite Pedion Areos). There is a bus service every 60 minutes, running from 6.30am until 9pm. For these bus services, there are also bus stops at

a) Fillelelinon Street (Syntagma Square)

b) Syggrou-Fix metro station

c) Kalamaki , bus stop n.3

d) Faliro

e) Voula

The bus fare is 4,70 euros and you will need to get off at the Eden Beach Resort bus stop that is located just outside the conference venue.

Athens City Centre-Anavyssos (via Saronida)

To get from Athens city centre to Anavyssos you can also use the **E22** bus service that departs from Academias Street (Athens city centre) and takes you to Saronida that is very close to the conference venue. You can then take a taxi to Eden Beach Resort.

For Conference Participants residing outside Athens

For those arriving to Athens by

a) KTEL buses (National Bus Service)

Kifissos KTEL Bus Station- Anavyssos

From Kifissos central bus station, you can use the **051** bus service to get to Omonia Square. You can then use the metro to get to Syntagma Square and then the KTEL bus service (**Athens-Anavyssos or Athens-Sounio service**) to Anavyssos. This bus service departs from Pedion Areos and runs every 60 minutes from 6am to 9pm. If you use this bus service, you will need to get off at the Eden Beach Resort bus stop that is located just outside the conference venue. The fare for this bus service is 4,70 euros.

b) Boat

Piraeus Port-Anavyssos

From Piraeus you can use the following bus services: **X96, 101, A1 or B1**. In any case, you will need to get off at Floisvos bus station. From there, you can use the **E22** bus service that will

take you to Saronida that is very close to the conference site. You can then take a taxi to Eden Beach Resort.

Alternatively, if you use any of the following bus services, i.e. **X96, A1, or B1**, that depart from Piraeus , you can get off at Kalamaki (bus stop n.3) and then use the KTEL bus service (Anavyssos-Sounio) that will take you to the conference venue.

Another option is to use the bus service n.**40** that departs from the Piraeus port, get off at Syntagma Square, and then use the KTEL bus service (Anavyssos-Sounio) that will take you to the conference venue.

c) Airplane

Eleftherios Venizelos Airport-Anavyssos

To get from the airport to the conference venue, you can either use the metro to Egaleo (or the suburban railway to Doukissis Plakentias and then the metro blue line to Egaleo). Another option is to use the X95 bus service.

No matter whether you decide to use the metro or the X95 bus service, you will need to get off at Syntagma Square and then get to Fillelinon Street. From there you can use the KTEL bus service that goes to Anavyssos (this bus service departs from Pedion Areos and runs every 60minutes from 6am to 9pm). If you use this bus service, you will need to get off at the Eden Beach Resort bus stop that is located just outside the conference venue. The fare for this bus service is 4,70 euros.

Alternatively, to get from the airport to the conference venue you can take a taxi. The cost will approximately be 35 euros (there is an extra cost of 10euros if it's after midnight).

d) Train

Larissis Central Railway Station –Anavyssos

From Larissis railway station, you can use the metro to Agios Dimitrios (red line, n.2) to get to Syntagma Square. Get off at Syntagma, go to Fillelinon Street and then use the KTEL bus service (**Athens-Anavyssos or Athens-Sounio service**) to Anavyssos. This bus service departs from Pedion Areos and runs every 60 minutes from 6am to 9pm. If you use this bus service, you will need to get off at the Eden Beach Resort bus stop that is located just outside the conference venue. The fare for this bus service is 4,70 euros.

C)Using your Own Car to get to the Conference Venue

2. If you are coming to Athens via the Athens-Patra National Road, you will need to turn right at Kifissos Avenue and head towards Piraeus (E75). The national road will take you to Posidonos Avenue (91) the extension of which is called Sounio Avenue. The conference venue is located at 47th Sounio Avenue.
3. If you are coming to Athens via the Athens-Lamia National Road, head towards Piraeus and take Posidonos Avenue (91) and head towards Anavyssos .The extension of Posidonos Avenue is called Sounio Avenue. The conference venue is located at 47th Sounio Avenue

Alternatively, you can use Attiki Odos. Follow the signs towards Markopoulo (E94) and at the end of Attiki odos take Markopoulos Avenue the extension of which is called Lavriou Avenue. Head towards Anavyssos. The extension of Lavriou Avenue is called Souniou Avenue. The conference venue is located at 47th Sounio Avenue.

Note: Please note that the travel expenses for those conference participants who reside in Athens (bus fares, metro tickets, cost of taxi etc.) will not be covered by the conference organizers.
